Typically, successful AP students are task oriented, proficient readers who manage time efficiently and make responsible decisions regarding their priorities.

Student, Parent, Teacher Responsibilities:

- Student: I agree to organize my time and effort to successfully complete AP English and understand it is my responsibility to complete course assignments prior to deadlines and to attend the class having done the required reading and homework. If needed, I will be responsible for notifying the teacher that extra help is desired and work to find a time when a meeting is mutually convenient.
- Parent/Guardian: I am familiar with the AP English course description and the texts listed and agree to help my child organize study time in support of class assignments. I will contact the teacher of any concerns that I have relating to the AP class or my child's progress.
- Teacher: I agree to teach the AP English course at a college level and pace consistent with the College Board expectations for such a course. I also agree to contact both the student and parent/guardian when concerns arise regarding a student's performance.

This class requires attendance at outside-of-class meetings. Considerable note taking, discussion and writing and reading practice will occur during and as a result of these meetings.
